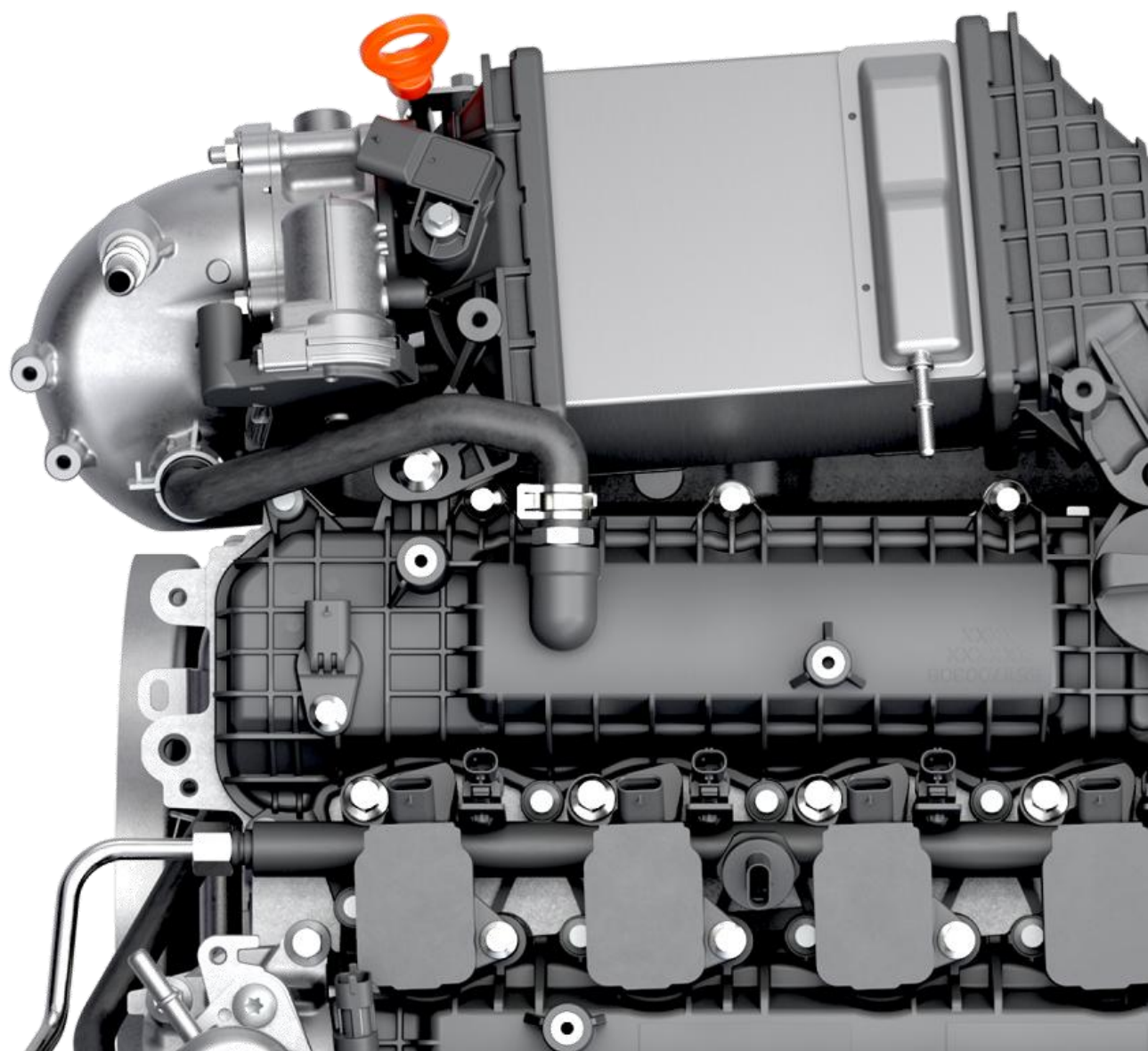


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1 Introduction

This Cookie Policy explains how HORSE Powertrain Limited with company number 15239961 and registered address of Monomark House, 27 Old Gloucester Street, London, England, WC1N 3AX, and/or our affiliated entities ("Horse Powertrain", "we", "our" or "us") use cookies when you visit our website www.horse-powertrain.com. This Policy was adopted by the CEO 02-09-2025.

In some cases, we may use cookies to collect personal data, or information that becomes personal data if we combine it with other information. In such cases, Horse Powertrain's privacy notice will apply and will supplement this Cookie Policy.

2 What are cookies?

A cookie is a small data file that is placed on your browser or the hardware of your computer or other device to allow a website to recognise you as a user when you return to the website. We may use the following types of cookies on our website:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website.
- **Analytical cookies (also known as statistical cookies).** These are cookies that allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors to our website, and to see how visitors move around our website. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies (also known as preference cookies).** These are cookies that allow us to recognise users when they return to our website and to embed functionality from third party services. This enables us to personalise our content for users, for example, by greeting users by name and remembering preferences.
- **Marketing cookies.** These are cookies that allow us to record users visits to our website, the pages visited, and the links followed. We use this information to make the advertising displayed more relevant. We may share this information with third parties for this purpose.

3 What cookies do we use?

You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in our consent management platform on our website. Please note that strictly necessary cookies will always be switched on by default. However, you can choose which analytical, functionality and advertising cookies we set.

Some third parties may set cookies on our website. We do not have any control over these cookies. Whilst we provide a summary of these, in our consent management platform, you should also check the relevant third party's website for more information about how these cookies are used.
